

POLICIES

Camping at MARIPOSA Ponds welcomes campers who share an appreciation of quality camping and a realization that our environment is a gift to be preserved and enjoyed. To keep and enhance the unique nature of MARIPOSA, those visiting are asked to observe the following policies:



Campsites are to be occupied by **one** family and one camping unit per site, no more than **six** people.

Visitors must register at the office, pay the fee, and agree to respect the rules of MARIPOSA.

Children are welcome and are to be under the supervision of parents or guardians at all times.

Pets, quiet and well-behaved, must be leashed or tied up and attended to by an adult at all times. Owners are asked to clean up promptly after their pets. Sorry, we cannot accommodate pets in any MARIPOSA rental unit or structure (lodge, pavilion, restrooms, pond, etc.) **No** pets during conference or fair weeks.

Quiet hours are 24 hours a day. No sounds should leave your campsite. Please adjust all volumes accordingly.

Speed is strictly limited to **5** MPH for the safety of all.

Off-road vehicles are **not** permitted at MARIPOSA. No vehicles are permitted on any of the nature trails. All bicyclists must wear helmets.

Alcoholic beverages are permitted only on your registered campsite and not in any other areas.

Smoking is **not** permitted in any MARIPOSA building/enclosure. Butts are not to litter the ground, roadways, fire rings, etc.

Trees or plants are **not** to be cut, defaced, nailed to, or damaged in any way. Any small branches that are down may be used for kindling. Firewood may be purchased at the store. The **pond** is for catch 'n' release fishing only. Please use barbless hooks.

Recycling is mandatory in Allegany County. Please comply by sorting your clean glass, metal and plastic into the appropriate Trash Stash containers. Non-recyclables must be in clear plastic bags and placed in designated cans. Deposit beverage containers donated to **PROJECT BUTTERFLY** are gratefully appreciated.

Picnic tables and fire rings are provided **one** per site. Please do not move them from other sites.
